- Complicated bereavement:
 - is easy to assess immediately after a person's loss
 - may appear the same as normal grief responses, but continues longer
 - is always evident in children after any loss of a family member
 - should be assessed before the person's loss so counseling can begin early
- The primary goal of bereavement counseling is to:
 - hasten the process of acceptance
 - provide cognitive therapy to those in need
 - assess the person for depression and suicidal ideation
 - assist the person through the steps of the mourning process
- Compassionate Friends is a national network of support groups for:
 - anyone who has lost someone to death
 - those over age 60 who have lost a spouse or significant other
 - parents of a child who has died
 - professional caregivers who work with the terminally ill
- Support groups for those in bereavement:
 - can be recommended as early as 2 weeks after the death of a loved one
 - should not be facilitated by laypersons
 - should pre-screen all potential members
 - work best if the members make their own rules for the group
- Strobe found those bereaved at the highest risk of suicidal ideation after the loss of a partner were:
 - women with perceived loss of social support and loneliness
 - women separated from spouse at time of death
 - both elderly men and women married for more than 50 years
 - men who believed they didn't support spouse during illness.
